**NOTE:** The courses listed above are subject to the following limitations:

- At the November 3, 1988, Faculty Meeting, the following Resolution was passed: "Papers submitted by students in satisfaction of the requirement for a course or seminar shall be due no later than the following dates: (1) no later than two quarters beyond the quarter in which the course or seminar commences; (2) in the case of a student graduating after the Spring Quarter, no later than June 30 of that year...Individual faculty members may require that papers be submitted at times earlier than these dates." This resolution went into effect at the start of Winter Quarter 1989.
- **A maximum of 15 credits** may be earned in the aggregate for all externships, with no more than 20 units of credit for externships and non-law course work combined. Clinic courses do not fall under this limitation.
- **<sup>1</sup>J.D. students may earn 6 credits maximum in the aggregate for Law 600 C, D, E, and F.**  
LL.M. students may earn 12 credits maximum in Law 600 A.
- **A maximum of 12 credits** may be earned in one academic year for E500, 600, and seminars combined; no more than 8 of these credits may be supervised by any one faculty member, and no more than 6 may be earned in any one quarter.
- The academic year begins with Summer Quarter and ends with Spring Quarter.
