

Subscribing to Podcasts

Begin by downloading iTunes from Apple's website (www.apple.com/itunes/download).

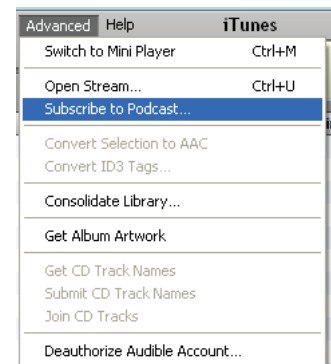
iTunes is a free download from Apple Inc. and the only podcast application supported by Computing Services. After downloading, install and launch iTunes.

Upon launching iTunes for the first time, you should be presented with a screen that looks like this:

In order to subscribe to a podcast you need to know its address. A podcast address looks a lot like any other web address, though it often ends in .xml or, in our case, .aspx. The address for your class will be provided to you by your professor.

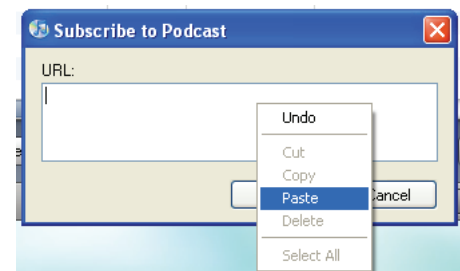


Select **Advanced** from the menu bar and from the drop down list select **Subscribe to Podcast...**



The **Subscribe to Podcast** menu will appear. Copy and paste or type the FULL podcast address into this dialog box. Click **OK**.

*Make sure the address starts with **https** and ends with **.aspx** and contains no spaces.*

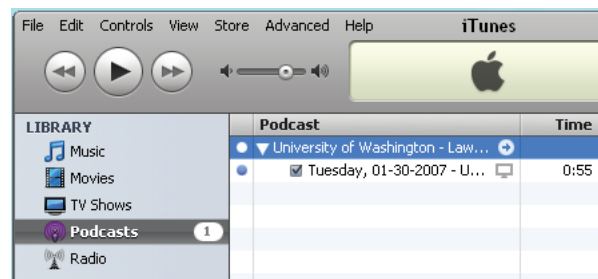

Subscribing to Podcasts cont...

After clicking **OK** you will be prompted for your UW NetID and Password. This is the same account information you use to access your UW email.



After successfully logging in, your podcast will begin to download.



To display more than the most recent recording, click the small grey triangle next to the podcast title so it points down, as seen in the illustration to the right.

To download additional recordings in the series, click on the **GET** button to the right of the desired recording.
